Privacy Policy

Welcome to CORACLE CAPITAL CONSULTING AND CORPORATE SERVICES PRIVATE LIMITED (the 'Company' or 'CORACLE'). The domain name <u>https://coraclefinance.com/main</u> ('Website') is owned by CORACLE, a company incorporated under the Companies Act, 2013 with its registered office at Plot No. 05, Block-A, 1st Floor, Milap Nagar, Uttam Nagar, Hastal Village, West Delhi, New Delhi-110059 and having head office at SA 15/121, 2nd Floor, Mawaiya, Ashapur, Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh-221007.

We, at CORACLE, respect the privacy of everyone who visits CORACLE's website and are committed to protecting their personal information. This Privacy Policy applies to CORACLE and to all visitors on the Website.

For the purpose of this Privacy Policy, the term "You", "Your", "User" shall mean any natural or legal person including online and offline clients visiting the Website and the term "We", "Us", "Our" shall mean CORACLE.

Use of the Website signifies your acknowledgement and free and unconditional consent to the Privacy Policy. If, however, You object to Your Information being used, processed and transferred by Us in any manner, please do not share your information on the Website.

This Privacy Policy is not intended to and does not create any contractual or other legal rights in favors of any user or viewer of <u>www.coraclefinance.com</u> or on behalf of any other party.

Type of Personal Information Collected

CORACLE may, for the purpose of rendering its services, collect personal information as described below:

- 1. Information that may be provided by You directly, such as:
 - a. Identification Information: Name, gender, residential/communication address, contact number, date of birth, marital status, email address or any other contact information.
 - b. PAN, KYC, Signature and Photograph.
 - c. Bank account or other payment instrument details.
 - d. Any other detail which may be required by Us for providing such services.

2. Information that We may collect from Your use of Our services, such as:

- a. Transaction Information: We read, collect and monitor only financial transactional SMS for description of the transactions and the corresponding amounts for credit risk assessment. Other SMS data is not accessed.
- b. Storage Information: We may facilitate user to download and display information such as scheme commission details which a user may refer to, or to upload relevant documents as per various processes during User account management or transaction order placement.
- c. Media Information: We facilitate Users to capture/upload relevant documents as may be required to be uploaded during user account management or transaction order placement.

- d. Device Information: We collect specific information about Your device when You access Our services, including Your storage, hardware model, operating system and version, unique device identifier, mobile network information, and information about the device's interaction with Our services.
- e. We read Name and Phone number information when You select the contact as a reference during the loan journey. We do not upload your contact list on Our servers.

3. Log File Information which shall be stored automatically:

If You visit/log into Our website just to browse, read pages or download information, certain information regarding Your visit is automatically stored on Our systems. This information cannot and does not identify You personally.

The kind of information that is gathered automatically includes without limitation:

- a. the type of browser You are using (e.g. Internet Explorer, Firefox, etc.);
- b. the type of Operating System You are using (e.g. Windows or Mac OS);
- c. the domain name of Your Internet Service Provider, the date and time of Your visit and the pages on Our website.

We sometimes use this information to improve Our website(s) design, and content, primarily to provide You with a better browsing experience.

Purpose of Collection and Usage of Information

On our Website, we collect, retain, and use information about you only when we reasonably believe that it will help administer our business or provide products, services, and other opportunities to you. Such information is collected for specified business purposes, such as:

- 1. to provide You with the services that You may require,
- 2. to process Your financial and non-financial transaction requests,
- 3. to undertake research and analytics for offering or improving Our services,
- 4. to check and process Your submitted applications, if any, for availing any financial services,
- 5. to share with You any updates/changes in Our services and their terms and conditions,

- 7. to respond to Your queries and feedback submitted by You,
- 8. for verification of Your identity and other parameters,

Disclosure of Information

The information provided by You may be disclosed to:

- 1. Collecting Banks/KYC Registration Agencies (KRAs) and other such agencies, solely for the purpose of processing your transaction requests for serving you better,
- 2. Another business entity to carry out any business activity or re-organization, amalgamation, restructuring of business or for any other reason whatsoever,
- 3. Any judicial or regulatory body,
- 4. Auditors,
- 5. Other third-party service providers.

We shall not publish the sensitive personal data or information or disclose it further, without Your explicit consent, for any purpose other than stated above.

The information collected shall be used for the purpose for which it has been collected.

Retention of Information

CORACLE shall not retain or store such information for periods longer than is required except when the information may lawfully be used or is otherwise required under any other law for the time being in force.

By agreeing to avail services offered by CORACLE, You have agreed to the collection and use of your Sensitive Personal Data or Information, as well, by CORACLE. You always have the right to refuse or withdraw Your consent to share/disseminate your Sensitive Personal Data or Information by contacting the customer care. However, in the event of Your refusal or withdrawal of personal data, You shall not be able to fully avail any services of CORACLE.

Communications & Notifications
